First Grade Head Coach David Warne's emphasis on defence throughout the week proved effective, with Drummoyne keeping Forest scoreless throughout the match. 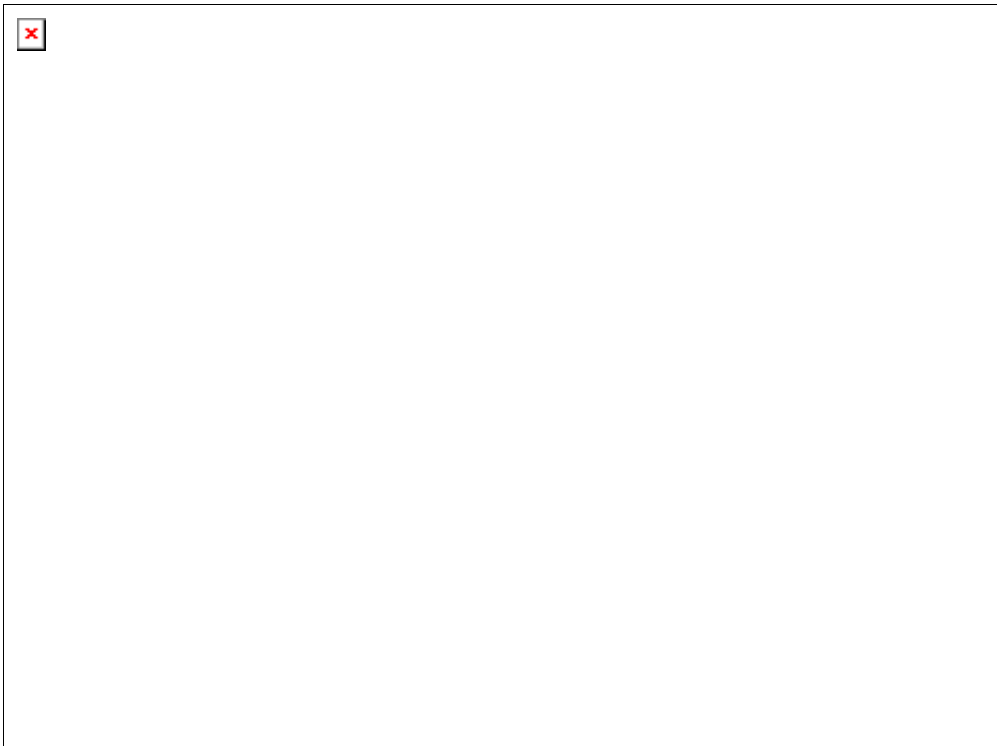
