Drummoyne vs. Campbelltown at Drummoyne Oval Saturday 5th of April 2008

The defending Kentwell Cup premiers continued where they left off last year by dominating Campbelltown in the first half. Flanker Dusty Elsom powered over from a ruck close to the opposition line and helped create another try for centre Pule Mesa with a thundering run through the middle of the Campbelltown pack. A first half lead of 20-3 was extended early in the second half due to a thirty metre run by number eight Trent Tapps and a sweeping backline move which resulted in winger Josh Asuausa's first try. A kick chase resulted in a turnover deep in the opposition half the ball went through three sets of hands before finding Josh Asuausa for his second try. The final score of 32-10 displayed that Drummoyne will be hard to beat this year.

Drummoyne Second Grade's forwards strong effort straight after kickoff was rewarded with a penalty try for foul play. A second try by wing Alex Farani helped the home to an early 12-0 lead. Campbelltown controlled possession for the rest of the half and scored a try right on half time to cut the home team's lead to 12-5. The second half was an arm wrestle with neither side scoring until a tackle busting run by winger Daryl Sanft five minutes from full time completed a 19-5 win for Drummoyne.

Drummoyne completed a clean sweep of all grades with third grade winning 22-12, Forth grade 20-5 and Fifth grade 34-7. Colts were unfortunate to go down 29-7.
