**Drummoyne vs. Mosman at Rawson Park 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2009.**

Drummoyne travelled to Rawson Park in Mosman to take on the Whales and were surprised when Mosman scored an early try after some poor close in defense. A midfield scrum produced a try in the corner for Drummoyne winger Willie Teo, then NSW suburban number eight Trent Tapp scored after the dominant Drummoyne scrum pushed over the try line to give the visitors a 10-8 lead at half time.

Drummoyne dominated territory for almost the entire half, but turnovers cost them just before scoring. Some sublime short passing and offloads by the forwards lead to a try by half-back Shannon Warren. The forwards dominated for the rest of the match with a try from a pick and drive, then flanker and Captain Nathan Landrey scoring the last try in the corner to give the reigning Kentwell Cup Premiers a 34-11 win, which lifted them into second place on the ladder.

Drummoyne seconds had a disrupted preparation which contributed to a very scrappy start, allowing three unanswered tries by Mosman in the first half. The second half produced some better attacking rugby by the visitors with tries to winger Wise Qalulu and centre Steve Ashton. Fullback Inoke Turuva was broke the defensive line at will but a mountain of turnovers killed off any hope the team had of running down the opposition, finally succumbing 41-12.

A late try to number eight Gareth Kelly allowed Third grade to hold off a fast finishing Mosman for a 19-10 win. Fourth Grade lost 31-0, while fifth grade continued their unbeaten run with a 14-10 win and colts lost 50-0.
