In one of the highest scoring matches of the year, points were scored at more than one a minute as Drummoyne continued their unbeaten record, accounting for University of NSW 55-32 in an entertaining display of attacking rugby. Drummoyne's first half tries came from scrum half Jesse Milford, winger Josh Asusasu, flanker Nathan Landrey and NSW Suburban representative number eight Trent Tapps. Uni scored three of their own tries to keep within striking distance at half time, 26-20.

Drummoyne poured on the points in the second half, with number eight Scott Monaghan making multiple line breaks, two of which led directly to tries to hooker Tim Cruikshank and Josh Asusasu. Winger Wise Gavida scored two of his own tries before setting up a try to lock Peter Goodall, whose hard hitting and high work rate throughout the match set the platform for the team's fourteenth consecutive victory.

Drummoyne Seconds were determined to exact revenge on their first round loss to Uni and were able to score two early tries to fly-half Mathew Pride and centre Martin Tevaga. Some ill-discipline cost Drummoyne a try, but scrum-half Ben Leaupepe snuck over for a late first half try to give Drummoyne a 19-10 lead at the break.

Drummoyne was forced to defend for long periods of time inside their own 22 as Uni battered the line, but were only able to come away with a single penalty goal. The back row of Dusty Elsom, Alex Cruikshank and William Fitzpatrick combined to score a long range try from a scrum within their own half which broke the spirit of the opposition. A second try by Martin Tevaga closed the match out 33-13.

Drummoyne Thirds won 9-0 to keep fourth spot on the ladder, fourth grade lost 17-3, fifth grade drew 0-0 and colts lost 29-13.
