### First Grade WON 20-13

The close rivalry of the Drummoynes and Knox sides continued, with the previous 3 meetings of the team being decided by less than a converted try, Knox winning the first round match 24-23 and Drummoynes winning the second round 24-17 and the Major Semi-final 17-11. Another close encounter was witnessed during the Grand Final at T.G. Milner Oval, Eastwood.

After receiving the kick off, Drummoynes held firm with Knox controlling possession in the opening minutes. The P.J. Gallagher Dirty Reds then worked their way up the pitch to the Knox 22, with Fetutasi Ma-Chong slotting a 25m field goal to open the scoring.

Knox could not breach the Drummoynes defence, so they settled for an equalising penalty goal before the Dirty Red forwards picked up the pace of the game attacked the Knox line with short runs around the base of the ruck. Flanker Ben Lonsdale eventually powered over the line from a metre out to score the first try of the game. Winger Tagi Isaia slotted the goal to take the lead to 10-3 into half time.

The start of the second half saw Drummoynes dominate territory, but the Knox defence held firm until a Knox clearance kick was collected by scrum half Shannon Warren who fended off a defender before offloading to winger Wes Talanoa, who broke through two tackles, then gave the ball back to Warren who scored in the corner.

Knox finally broke through the Drummoynes defence and scored a converted try to close the gap to 15-10, before Isaia was sin binned for a high tackle. Even with a man down, Knox could not breach the defence and settled for a penalty goal.

Ma-Chong was soon also sin binned for a high tackle, reducing Drummoynes to thirteen players with less than fifteen minutes remaining. The Drummoynes forwards picked and drove the ball towards the Knox line, a metre at a time, sucking in the defence and running down the clock until a penalty was awarded fifteen metres from the opposition try line. Captain Nathan Landrey decided to take a scrum instead of a penalty goal that would have only extended the lead to five points. The Dirty Red scrum drove back the Knox scrum until it collapsed, allowing for another reset, which number eight Terry Langi picked up and passed to Talanoa, who powered over the line for a try in the corner, which sealed the match and the 2010 Kentwell Cup for Drummoynes.

Fua Veiru was named the Golden Boots winner for best on ground.

Fifth Grade also won their first Sutherland Cup premiership, beating Old Ignatians 20-10.
